Tribal Visit

Second year students of English Department organized a trip to Wayanad Wild Life Sanctuary ON 5 November 2019. They had an interactive session with the forest officer Beerankutty accompanied by Dr. Aswathy V K , Sociologist of Wayanad Wildlife Division, Sulthanbathery. Thirty Nine students and three faculty members were participated in the trekking, where the forest officer gave insight into the life of tribal community; the dependence of the tribal community to the resources of the forest, different schemes implemented for their upliftment and the role of "Asha workers" in their

community. Later the students had a meeting with the tribal community belonging to "kattunayka" community. The students were given a brief idea regarding the schemes implemented among the community. Experiencing the culture and customs of those still living closely tied to nature and the inhabitants of pristine and picturesque environments, made our students understand the importance of preserving nature and how the lives of tribal are much needed for the sustainability of nature. criteria, basic qualifications and syllabus to cover in order to prepare for various government jobs. The programme was a great success with the participants from various departments.

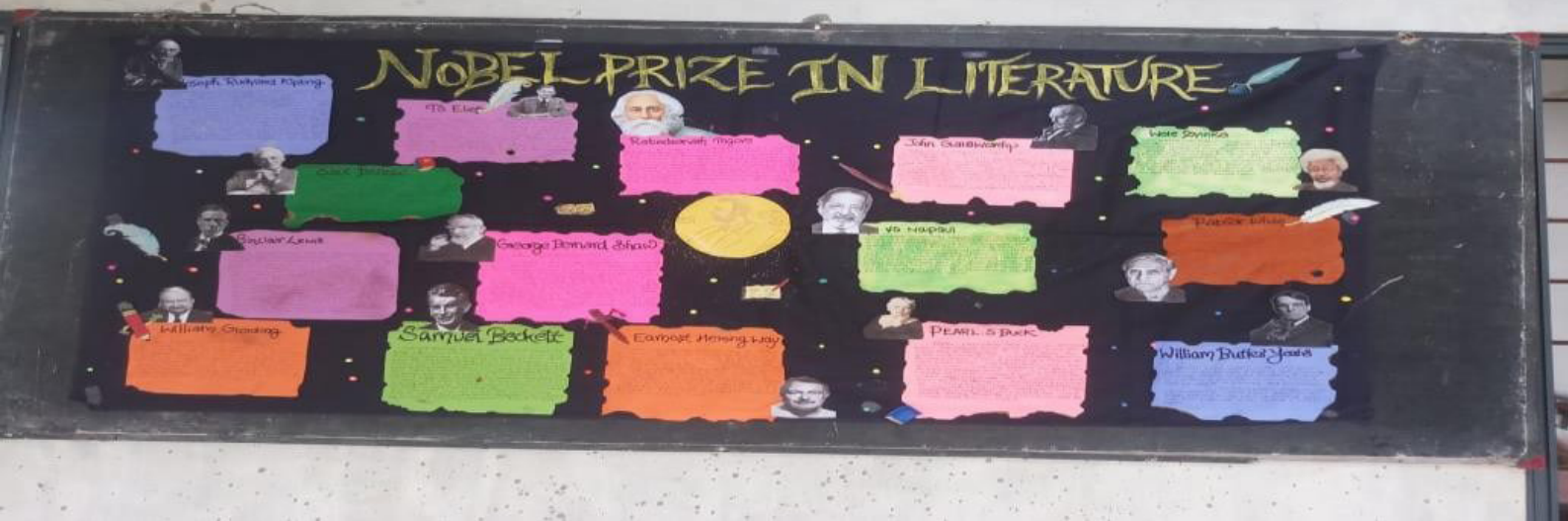


Keralappiravi Day Celebration

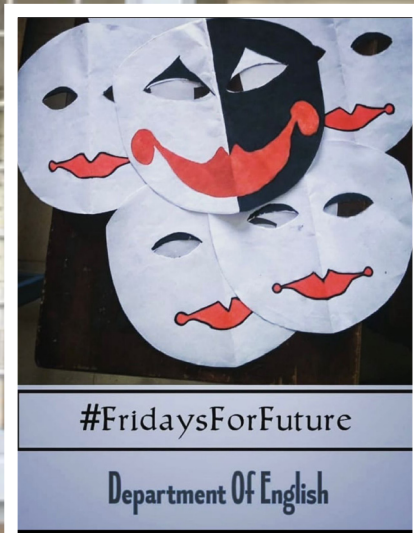
Onam Celebration & Old Age Home Visit
